

How to complete the ESA 2026 upgrade course step by step


1

Invitation by email

- Everyone with a valid EBR ESA certificate after **31 May 2026** will receive an invitation to the upgrade course by email during **week 9**. The invitations will be sent out in batches throughout the week.
- In the invitation, the participant chooses to start the course in Swedish, “**Börja här**”, or in English “**Start here**”.
- During the first login, the participant need to create a password.

If the participant has **not received the invitation by the end of week 10** (after verifying their spam folder), please contact our support:



Start the course


- For the English version, the participant must first **select “Registrera”** to enroll in the English course.
- On the course page, the participant begins by clicking the yellow **Start course** button.
- The upgrade course can be paused at any time and resumed later. Participants can always return to the course via the link in the invitation.

Course structure

- The upgrade course is divided into modules. Each module ends with **control questions**, and participants have **unlimited attempts**.
- The total time required is approximately **30 minutes**, covering key updates and changes introduced in **EBR ESA 26**.



Completed course

- The upgrade course concludes with a **knowledge test** consisting of **15 questions**, including some repeated from the module questions.
- To pass the course and receive the **certificate**, the participant must answer **14 out of 15** questions correctly.
- There are **unlimited attempts** on both the control questions in the course and the final knowledge test.

Certificate

- The certificate can be downloaded directly from the learning platform once the participant has passed the knowledge test.
- Within approximately one week, the certificate will also be available under **My Pages > My Certificates (wattityd.se)** and searchable via [Search approved EBR ESA certificates](#).
